Through our projects, we provide comprehensive support to women experiencing homelessness from a clear gender perspective. We offer them individual housing and provide access to a specialized team trained in trauma-informed care, supporting them in their recovery and in rebuilding their life projects. In addition, we support them through professional training and employment pathways.

Specifically, your contribution supports the development of the **Retocar Madera Training Workshop–Studio**, which includes recovery and employment training pathways for the participating women. In the 2025 edition, this has resulted in 10 women improving their professional skills and gaining new tools that will help them obtain and maintain employment.

Through the **Retocar Madera Training Workshop–Studio**, we ultimately promote improved employability, active inclusion, and personal recovery, as well as the rebuilding of a life project.
